Nuremberg, Njemačka
od 15. do 16. svibnja 2008.

»Aktivacija« je postala značajna paradigmata kada je riječ o tržištu rada i socijalnim politikama u Europi. Ne samo da je u kratkom vremenu ušla u politički govor u mnogim europskim zemljama, već je postala ključna referentna točka za restrukturiranje socijalnih država, njihovih zakonskih okvira, političkih programa i socijalnih usluga.

Nasuprot SAD-u, koje bilježe rast siromaštva i socijalne isključenosti, u Europi postoji konsenzus da je osnovna odgovornost socijalne države osiguranje minimuma životnog standarda građana. Tako se u europskom političkom životu sve više upotrebljava izraz »fleksigurnosti« (*flexicurity*), koji implicira povećanje fleksibilnosti tržišta rada uz zadržavanje potrebne razine socijalne sigurnosti.

Između ostalog, konferencija će otvoriti pitanja o tome da li postoji specifičan europski model aktivacije te kakve rezultate polučuje metoda otvorene koordinacije u Europskoj uniji, o iskustvima i primjerima dobre prakse programa aktivacije na lokalnoj razini, metodološkim pristupima u evaluaciji programa, povezanosti aktivacije tržišta rada i socijalne isključenosti te drugim relevantnim pitanjima.

International conference: “Activation policies on the fringes of society: a challenge for European welfare states”

Nuremberg, Germany
May 15 – 16, 2008.

Activation has become a prominent paradigm with regard to both labour market and social policies in Europe. Not only has it permeated political oratory in a short period of time across a wide range of European countries, but it has also become a crucial reference point for the restructuring of the modern welfare state in its legal and administrative structures, in its political programmes and social services.

Contrary to the US, where poverty and social exclusion have increased, in Europe there is a strong consensus on the fact that the welfare state has essential responsibilities in securing a minimum living standard of its citizenry. “Flexicurity” became a political catch-word intended to represent a political paradigm which implies improving flexibility on the labour market while guaranteeing a sufficient level of social security at the same time.

The conference will address questions on whether there is a specific European agenda of activation and what is the impact of the EU’s Open Method of Coordination, on what experiences are being made and if there are best practices at local level. Further, it will be discussed what are the methodological requirements for evaluation of activation programmes, what is the interplay between labour market activation and social exclusion and other relevant issues. Therefore, the conference organized on the 80. anniversary of the ICSW will focus on three domains of social welfare: social work, social protection and social development. Within the first plenary session on social work, it will be discussed the growing role of civil society, the role of social workers in the struggle against inequalities and discrimination and what are the targets of social work. Further, the plenary session on social protection will address the issue of demographic and financial pressures on welfare systems, work and employment in a global world and the question of challenging new risks. Finally, the plenary session on social development will enable the debate on poverty reduction policies, human rights, multiculturalism, sustainable development and other related issues.

Social Indicators have been designed primarily to measure the quality of life of the individual citizen and societal qualities, to monitor respective changes across time and to compare how people live in different nations as well as various population groups within countries.

Sustav indikatora, zajedno sa socijalnom slikom kao najznačajnijim primjerom primjene socijalnih indikatora, pružaju odgovor na pitanje: Da li se stvari mijenjaju na bolje ili na gore i zašto? Pored opisnih podataka o trenutnom stanju stvari i tome da li se ono mijenja na bolje ili na gore, uvid u mehanizme u pozadini tih procesa od ključne je važnosti pri kreiranju i usmjeravanju politika.

Sjednica radne grupe »Socijalni indikatori« bit će prilika za prezentaciju rezultata istraživanja o trendovima društvenog razvoja, kao i za ocjenu značaja socijalnih indikatora i socijalnih slika u vođenju javnih politika. Radna grupa poziva na slanje radova na temu praćenja kvalitete života temeljeno na indikatorima, radova koji se bave pitanjima metodologije istraživanja te primjera dobre prakse u izradi socijalnih slika. Nadalje, dobrodošli su radovi u kojima se raspravljaju jakosti i slabosti upotrebe indikatora, kao i primjeri pojedinačnih inicijativa za praćenje i izradu socijalnih slika u svrhu kreiranja politika.

Indicator systems as well as social reports as a major application of social indicators research are thus providing answers to the elementary question: "Are things getting better or worse, and why?" Beyond the descriptive information on how things are and whether they are changing to the better or worse, it is of crucial importance for 'steering' and policy making to get causal insights into the mechanisms behind those processes.

The sessions organised by Working Group 'Social Indicators' will provide opportunities to present results of research on monitoring trends social progress and to reflect the role of social indicators and social reporting to guide public policy. The Working Group welcomes papers addressing the issues on indicator-based monitoring of the quality of life and societies, papers on related methodological issues and examples of 'good practice' in policy-relevant social measurement and reporting. Also papers discussing the characteristics which qualify or disqualify indicators as well as specific monitoring and reporting initiatives for policy making purposes would be welcomed.

Population ageing is not necessarily apocalyptic for individuals, societies and their social systems – it means finding new ways of communicating between the generations, of supporting each other, of social inclusion and social integration. Ageing can become a risk factor – or an opportunity for realising new potentials.

Increasingly individualised life courses mean growing “diversities of ageing” – and more diversity in “discourses and debates” about ageing.
